The Church of St. John in the Wilderness (Episcopal) is a recipient of a Sacred Sites grant in support of the recent Bell Tower Project. The Rev. John P. Thompson is Rector. The church building, built in 1852, was designed by Richard Upjohn, architect of Trinity Church on Wall Street, New York, and founding president of the American Institute of Architects. The church is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is also part of the Copake Iron Works Historic District, also on the National Register. The church has 70 members, serves the Roe Jan area of Eastern Columbia County, and is located on State Route 344 in Copake Falls, on the road to Bash Bish Falls.
